During this period, we have maintained our commitment to our mission of promoting human development and building a more just and equitable world, always preserving the dignity of people. Looking to the future, we build on the achievements made in 2022 to continue working with greater determination effectiveness.

In this way, we have continued our work in vulnerable communities in Asia, Africa and Latin America, hand in hand with our local partners, with the aim of improving the living conditions of thousands of people. Thus, we have carried out twenty-three projects that have contributed to food security, access to drinking water, education, health, decent employment, economic empowerment and environmental protection, giving special importance to the role and leadership of women in India, Lebanon, Jordan, Egypt, Palestine, Ethiopia, Kenya, Uganda, Cameroon, Nicaragua, Bolivia, Guatemala and Peru.

For this reason, we have continued our activity of sustainable education for development through the initiatives "Objective 2030: EFAS for Development" and Youth MUN Madrid, in Spain, and our participation in forums and solidarity initiatives. The work of our think tanks has also continued: Center for Middle East Studies (CEMO) and Women and Equality Observatory (OMEI), so that, through research and analysis of social and political problems, recommendations based on evidence that helps to improve decision-making and promote the welfare and development of society.

I would also like to highlight our presence in the United Nations, thanks to our general consultative status, actively participating in different forums and meetings. We have collaborated strongly with other civil society organizations and governments to promote agendas in favor of the eradication of poverty, equality, environmental protection and the promotion of peace and justice.
